APRIL — DAY 13 HOURS, NIGHT 11

The biblical 14th of Nissan which brings the full moon announcing the Pasch of the Law (read Exodus 12.5) falls this year on Monday, April 18 (=5 April Julian). The Orthodox Catholic Church of the East always wants the Christian Pasch to follow the Pasch of the Law (*i.e.*, the Old Testament Pasch) which it fulfills and perfects. Consequently Holy Friday is April 22, and Resurrection Sunday is the 24th (=11 April Julian). And this year for the second year in a row the Latin West will celebrate together with us and after the Pasch of the Law which is a detail their tradition does not care about to the abiding annoyance of the Eastern Church.
